Competition Procedure

This meet is a FINA approved qualification meet.

This competition is certified generally in accordance with FINA rules and under the event regulations of the Swimming Federation of Latvia.

The competition is held with preliminaries and finals A and B for all 50 m, 100 m individual events.

The competition is held with preliminaries and final for all 200 m individual events.

The competition is held with timed finals for all 400 m, 800 m, 1500 m individual and relay events with the fastest heat swimming in the Evening session for the individual events.

!! If in 50m or 100m events only two heats (less than 17 participants) are entered, the B final is cancelled!!

!! If there is only one heat (less than 9 participants) entered the timed final is moved to the evening session!!

There will be a maximum of 4 foreign swimmers permitted to qualify to each of the finals. Every swimmer must make registration before the heats of the event in the call room, otherwise the disqualification will be applied accordingly.

Penalty fee for not attending to the start (mark 'DNS' in the Official Results) – 10 EUR (individual event), relay event – 20 EUR.

2 substitutes swimmers for the finals are announced, and they must arrive into call room, before the final, otherwise the penalty fee of 10 EUR will be applied in case of missed start (mark 'DNS' in the Official Results).

Withdrawals from the finals must be given to the secretary of the competition within 30 minutes from the announcement of the final.

Withdrawals from finals must be given to the secretary of the competition within 30 minutes from the announcement of the final(-s)/reserve.

Deposit in case of protest is 50 EUR.

Entries

Preliminary Entry Form to be received by the Swimming Federation of Latvia by the 20th January 2022.

Final Entries should be submitted using the Online Entry System that can be found on the address: https://www.swimrankings.net/manager/.

By default technical entry times for an individual and relay events will be based on information from the European Swimming Federation (LEN) rankings database and other FINA members' competition results that are achieved in Open Competition between the period from 19th November 2020 till 18th of February, 2022 and can be found on the website: www.swimrankings.net.

Swimmers, who's achieved results from the database mismatch with the results from technical entry, will start with mark 'NT'.

All competing swimmers must be entered in the meet (even if they are not swimming in individual events) and relay entries should be filled with the names of the swimmers respectively (with the only exception of the mix relays in case of the Online Entry System malfunction).

Entry Reports must be sent by the team representative and received by the Swimming Federation of Latvia by midnight on 18th February 2022 by e-mail to the address: info@swimming.lv indicating in the e-mail subject the names of the meet and the team.

The entries should consider received after the sender has got the confirmation e-mail (replay). If the entries have not being sent through the National swimming federation those are considered accepted after receiving the confirmation from the National swimming federation (which should be the FINA member).

All names and surnames for all the team representatives must be sent by e-mail together with the Entry Report to the e-mail address: info@swimming.lv (see point "Accreditation"). Withdrawals from the competition can be made till 19:59 o'clock of 22nd of February 2022. The last corrections (substitutions only) for an individual or relay events shall be submitted to the secretary of the competition no later than 1 hour before the start of the session in which the race takes place.

By submitting the entries, the represented organization confirms all participants' eligibility of their health conditions and ability of all entrants to take part in competition, and takes the full responsibility of their health insurance, accommodation, catering and travel etc. expenses.

- 5.44.2. <u>only persons who have a vaccination certificate or certificate of recovery participate in the competitions and are present at their venue</u> and the requirements laid down in Sub-paragraph 5.24 of this Order in relation to organizing of public events are ensured;

5.44.3. two-meter distance is maintained during a visit to the site where indoor sports competitions take place, and also face masks are used (except for athletes during the course of sports competitions);

5.44.4. athletes of one team (also in individual types of sport) or sports employees serving athletes do not come into physical contact with athletes of other teams or sports employees serving other athletes (except for athletes during the course of the sports competitions);

5.44.5. the occupancy of locker rooms does not exceed 25 %;

5.44.6. giving of awards on site takes place only individually.
